## COST INCLUDES

- **Employer Orientation:** Welcome session with best practices, what to expect from the program, and more.
- **Kick-Off Event:** Professional development workshop that can include a focus on communication, networking, and leadership skills.
- **Weekly Professional Development Trainings:** Presentations and discussions that may consist of topics such as emotional intelligence, problem solving, and communication.
- **Five Half-Day Excursions:** Activities to showcase the cultural, recreational, and outdoor amenities in each of the NRV communities.
- **Wrap-Up Event:** Graduation ceremony and networking session with employers and area young professionals.
