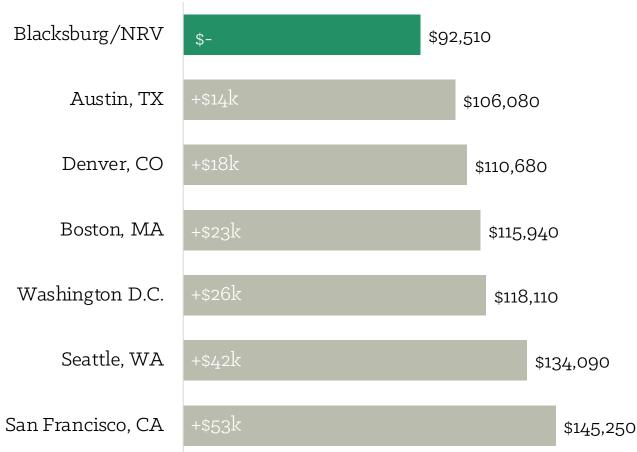

Average Salaries for Software Developers



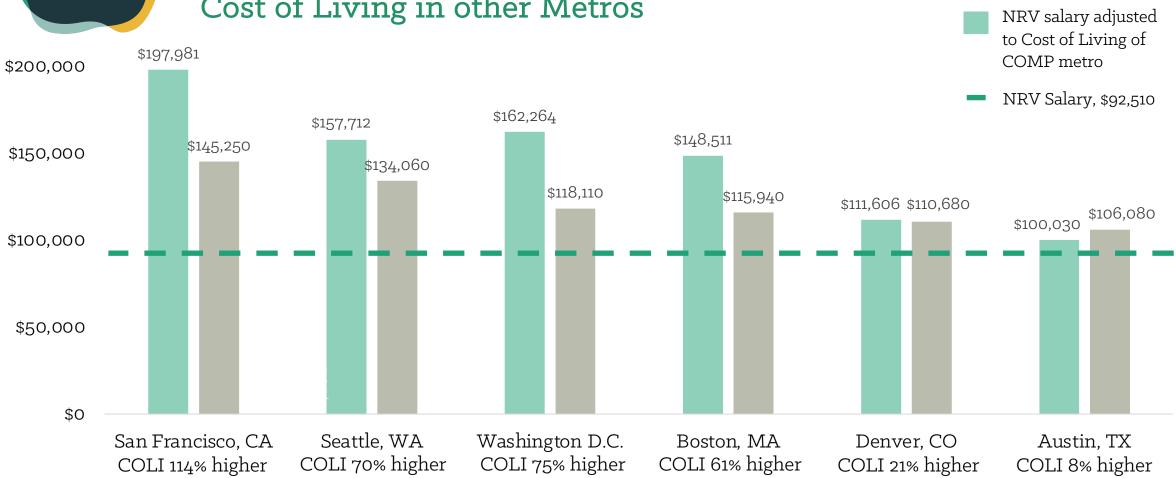




LESS IS MORE IN THE NRV

NRV Software Developer Salary Adjusted to Cost of Living in other Metros



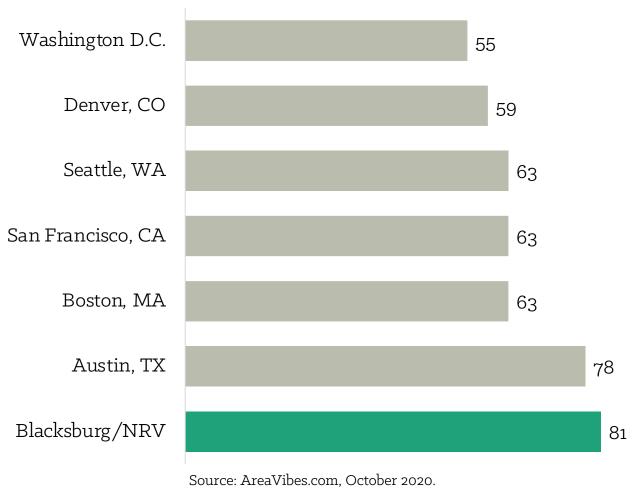

In 2020, U.S News & World Report ranked Blacksburg High School within the top 10% of public high schools in the U.S. based its high graduation rate and college readiness scores.













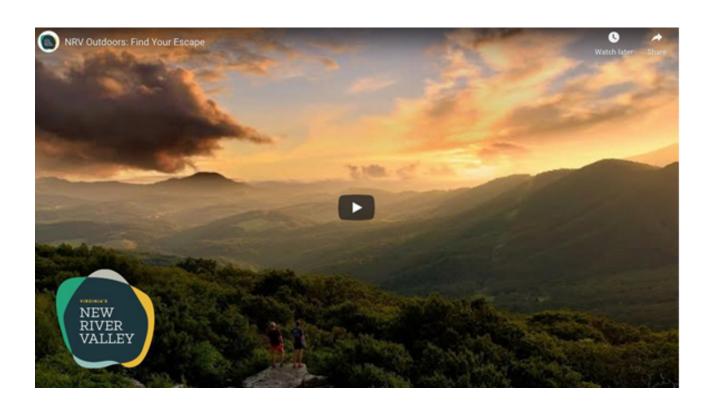
